


Smart Play Ball User Manual

Model: PBL010





Meet your play ball






How it works:

- Random rolling: automatic steering when encountering obstacles
- Smart working mode: After waking up by shaking, work for 5minutes (rolling for 30 seconds, stopping for 6 seconds), automatically sleeping after 5 minutes.

Operations:

1.Power on the ball

Unscrew the ball cover counterclockwise and click on the main power button.



2. Wake up or turn off the ball

After closing the ball cover, wake up or turn off by shaking. (Shake in the up and down direction when waking up, please swing up and down in the direction of the scent emitting holes)




3.Charging

Unscrew the ball cover and connect the Micro USB cable to the charging port.



Open the top of the scent chamber and add the appropriate amount of catnip.

Precautions

- When turning on or off by shaking, the sensitivity of the ball is affected by strength;
- In the standby state, if the pets shake the ball to a higher intensity, it is normal to wake up the ball into motion.
